Leisure Centre joins nationwide fitness network

Carn Brea Leisure Centre Trust, Cornwall's first Charitable Trust leisure centre, has entered a 12 month pilot scheme creating a fitness industry network of over 200 centres nationwide.



The UK Fitness Network (UKFN), which launches on 1st September 2011, is the result of a partnership formed between the UK's not for profit leisure centres and clubs. It will allow members of UKFN registered centres to use centres run by differing Trusts without the requirement of a gym induction, giving their members pay per session access to over 100 gyms, 100 pools and 1000 fitness classes across the country.

There are currently 202 registered centres, run by 26 Sporta trusts, but the scheme will be reopened in December this year allowing more of Sporta's 101 cultural and leisure trust members to sign up to the UKFN free of charge.

Barry Holding, Centre Manager at Carn Brea, says: 'We are very pleased to have become part of the UK Fitness Network. As a Charity, offering the community the opportunity to be physically active, it's great to be able to make it easier for our members to exercise wherever they are.'
